As of 09:00 A.M., Monday, August 28, 2017 (today) the following regulations are in effect for Wayne County waterways;

Emergency Orders issued by the Towns of Huron and Wolcott for Port Bay has been terminated.

Port Bay, Sodus Bay and Blind Sodus Bay are all being governed by the Navigation Law requiring a "**100 foot No Wake Zone**".

Lake Ontario is still under the New York State Emergency Order issued by Governor Cuomo of 5MPH within 600 feet from the shoreline.

The Navigation Law requires a 100 foot No Wake Zone, but Sheriff Virts continues to urges boaters to stay as far away as possible from any shoreline to reduce shoreline erosion, protect property, to avoid floating debris and docks that may still be submerged.
