Supervisor Chatfield called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

Pledge of Allegiance -

The purpose of this special meeting (workshop) was to discuss the potential changes to our current Land Use Code and any other business that might come before the board.

LAND USE CODE -

Supervisor Chatfield asked Code Enforcement Officer, Don Camp, to offer his comments first. Don referred to the

section in our current Land Use Code regarding the waterfront district. He stated the difference between the current regulations from the year 2000 and the draft regulations compiled in 2002 for the waterfront district. Don also mentioned docks in the waterfront district, as our assessor would like to be notified when a dock is built. Discussion.

The next topic of discussion was in regards to the Planning Board. In the 2000 Land Use Code there is no reference to a Planning Board but there is in the 2002 draft. Discussion.

Lynn will talk with our attorney about the aforementioned topics and we will proceed with his recommendations as to the process of how the 2000 Land Use Code needs to be revised. (Later in the meeting Don referred to the map on last page of the 2000 Land Use Code and the draft 2002 Land Use Code. He pointed out that the waterfront district was modified in the draft. Discussion.)

OTHER BUSINESS -

NEW DRUG & ALCOHOL TESTING CONTRACT -

RESOLUTION #48-16 AUTHORIZING THE SUPERVISOR TO SIGN A CONTRACT WITH ADVANCED OCCUPATIONAL SERVICES FOR DRUG AND ALCOHOL TESTING FOR THE TOWN OF WOLCOTT HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT -

The following resolution was presented by Adam Ellis, moved by Chris Loveless, seconded by Russ Freer,

WHEREAS, a proposal to provide drug and alcohol testing for the Town of Wolcott Highway Department was recently submitted by Cathy Willmott of Advanced Occupational Services; and

WHEREAS, the Town Clerk contacted our current provider, SCS Drug Testing, for an updated price list to compare with the proposal sub-mitted by Cathy Willmott; and

WHEREAS, our current drug and alcohol testing provider, SCS Drug Testing, recently increased their charges with a \$40 fee per on-site visit which Advanced Occupational Services does not charge; and

WHEREAS, the Town needs to be fiscally responsible by contracting with the more economical provider;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Supervisor is authorized to sign a contract with Cathy Willmott of Advanced Occupational Services for drug and alcohol testing for the Town of Wolcott Highway Department.
